





SHRINE HEADQUARTERS MAILED OUT YOUR 2023 DUES RENEWAL NOTICE BY EMAIL ON SEPTEMBER 7th.* PLEASE CHECK YOUR EMAIL. DUES ARE DUE JANUARY 1ST—PAYING IN ADVANCE SAVES YOUR TEMPLE THE EXPENSE OF SENDING OUT REMINDER LETTERS BY MAIL.

2023 DIGITAL MEMBERSHIP DUES CARD

SHRINERS INTERNATIONAL has announced a <u>new digital membership card</u>. Effective now, Nobles who pay their 2023 dues will have immediate access to a newly designed digital Membership card. Nobles can access and present their card, which features the status of their dues two ways:

- My FezCard Viewer available for download on Apple App Store or Google Play App Store
- Member Center located on the new SI.org Website

For 2023, the two primary methods to determine if a member is current in their dues are: Asking the Noble to present their digital membership card on a mobile device; or for the Temple, club, or unit to scan the QR code on an existing dues card. Scanning the QR code either on the existing hard card or the new digital card, provides several benefits to the temple including in the areas of operations and as a member engagement tool:

- Decreases temple expenses by not having to pay for stickers and buckslip insert
- Simplifies operations, no need to replace stickers on an annual basis
- Digital card/scanning QR quickly determines the status of dues payment
- Awarding credit for attendance at events and activities, which is especially handy for temples that award points and prizes for participation
- Participating in contests and giveaways
- Expressing an interest in joining a club or unit
- Registering for an event or volunteer opportunities

As a result, Shriners International has discontinued the distribution of dues stickers to individual Nobles. While the focus remains on scanning the QR code or presenting the digital card to determine the status of dues, to assist in the transition, a limited number of 2023 stickers will be sent to each temple so they can provide a dues sticker to Nobles on a case-by-case or as requested basis.

When Nobles pay their 2023 membership dues they will receive a 5x8 acknowledgment postcard that will announce the new process along with instructions on how to obtain their new digital membership card. To address three commonly asked questions:

- 1. <u>How can a Noble access their digital card if we don't have internet access?</u> If internet connectivity is a concern, once the Noble accesses their card via one of the two options above, they can take a screenshot of the digital card, which automatically saves to their photo gallery. Thereafter, they can present the card as needed without needing an internet connection.
- 2. <u>How can a temple, club, or unit scan a QR code?</u> For the last three years, Temples have been scanning the QR code on the existing membership card to determine dues by purchasing a handheld scanner, available for as little as \$30, or a mobile device, like a phone or tablet. Both options connect and communicate with WebFez.

In 1922, the Shriners fraternity established a charitable hospital to assist with the polio epidemic sweeping the nation. Generations later, Shriners Children's Greenville is celebrating the system's 100th Anni-

versary. This hospital is home to the largest team of orthopaedic surgeons in South Carolina. At the annual celebration, expert physicians spoke on advancements in patient care and attendees met some of the patients whose lives have been changed by the care they have received.

Attending this year's event were Greenville Board of Governors Member Noble Brandon Brown and Lady Erin, Illus. Sir Terry Yancy and Lady Pam, Noble Jerry Colanter and Lady Sylvia, and Lady Regina Pipes. Our Ladies represented Bahaca Court #90 Ladies Oriental Shrine.

The hospital system has begun working closely with the Ronald McDonald House to provide housing for families during their appointments and admissions, benefiting Cahaba and other Shrine Temples who transport patients to Greenville.



How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the Register button on the Login page.
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Shrine ID (found on your membership card) and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.

- Scroll down to read the WebFez User Agreement and Privacy policy. Agree by clicking the checkbox.
- After the checkbox is selected, click on Register. This will Register you for WebFez and log you into the system.

HOW TO DOWNLOAD AND USE "MY FEZCARD VIEWER"

I-PHONE: Open App store; search for "My FezCard Viewer"; click "Install"

Android: Open Google Play store; search for "My FezCard Viewer"; click "Install"

Open My FezCard Viewer. Enter your Shrine ID and Last Name. Type your Temple name and click on it to highlight it. Click "Register" at the bottom. You only need to register once.

At bottom of screen, you have 2 options: Shrine Card and OR code.

You can click "QR Code" or swipe the screen left to view the code for easy scanning at Temple events.

NOTICE OF STATED SHRINE MEETING AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS FRIDAY, DECEMBER 2, 2022 AT CAHABA SHRINE

7:30 p.m. - Opening of the Temple, Regular Order of Business, Election of officers

You will elect the following: Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest & Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder, Imperial Reps, Southeastern Reps, Dixie Reps and 2 Finance Committee Members.

325.11 Election Regulations:

- (a) Electioneering: A candidate of an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) Expenditures Prohibited: The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation: For any violation of (a) or (b) the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice: At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.
