HOSPITAL BOARD REPORT

Noble George A. Pipes

Emeritus Board Member, Shriners Hospitals for Children-Greenville Co-Chairman, Public Relations Committee

Happy New year and may it be one full of happiness and brotherly love.

I mentioned in the last issue of this publication that I would not be publishing a hospital report again but I just can't help myself, That said, I will do my best to keep this one short and to the point.

Our December board meeting is now history as is 2015 so I thought it might be appropriate to provide some statistics (effective 30th November) reflecting how your Greenville Hospital has been doing:

- We accepted 262 patients for treatment (2069 YTD) had 1,221 outpatient appointments (9,743 YTD) and 93 surgical cases (810 YTD).
- ♦ Our wait to clinic time of 17.4 days as compared to 60.35 days last year at this time is a tremendous improvement. This is perhaps one of the most important statistics we track as it has such a direct impact on our ability to <u>promptly</u> help Children. Not coincidently it also helps in our ability to grow our patient population, remember our purpose is to help Kids.
- Of the six measurements we use to track Patient satisfaction our current average score is 97% with a near identical score for YTD. Our goal is to reach 99%, a very aggressive measurement but one we feel is an attainable target with continued focus and constant improvement.
- ♦ We added 187 new patients (2,758 YTD), Cahaba was responsible for 1 (14 YTD). Your help is critical to growing this number. If you know of a child that can benefit from our world class services gently / compassionately educate their parents/guardians on what we provide. It just might make a difference in that Childs life!

The patient family rooms I commented on in the last Cahaban are completed now and are nothing short of fantastic. Six rooms are now available to parents whose child has an extended stay at our hospital - first come, first served basis.

Each year the hospital schedules an annual board meeting and invites Nobles, their families, and all friends of the hospital to attend. The date for the 2016 event will be **March 11**th and 12th. Kindly mark your calendars, additional information will be provided in future communications.

As always, I'd like to extend a special thanks to our brave warriors of the road, our road runners, for all the hours they spend and miles they drive in support of our shrine kids and their families. God Bless, take care, and again, have a great and fruitful new-year.

One man in North Alabama who has shown by his accomplishments he deserves a "pat on the back" is Floyd Hambrick of Section Al. He deserves a "thank you from the bottom of our hearts". Floyd has served our country in many ways.

He excelled as a basketball official in high school for 36 years. His expertise in the game and his determination to be impartial was well recognized. He made the game more fun to watch. His reputation as a referee and the way he performed was a factor in his being elected Probate Judge of Jackson County (a position he held for 18 years).

No task is too small for him to carry out. Floyd has been very busy for the past six months as he supervised the completion of a large, new facility, located on Blake bottom road (Cahaba Shrine). This has been a very difficult task but he has done an outstanding job.

He has conducted many Masonic graveside rites. This is the last way that we can show reverence to a fallen brother, Mason, or Shriner. The work he has done in his lifetime is a true reflection of the man he is. He is a devoted Christian and belongs to the Section United Methodist Church.

He was a member of the Armed forces and served in the army during the Viet Nam conflict. Floyd was a past commander of the Scottsboro American Legion.

His travel through the Masonic and Shrine Kingdome began in a small place in Jackson County called Princeton. It was on October 12, 1977 when Floyd hit the ground running through the Masonic and Shrine Kingdom. He was honored by being elected Worshipful Master in his lodge located in Holly Grove. His leadership position lasted two years—1966-1967.

Some of the organizations to which he has belonged were Cahaba Shrine, Jackson County Shrine Club, Scottsboro Masonic Lodge, Eastern Star, Fort Payne York Rite, Scottsboro York Rite, DeMolay Club, Scottish Rite, and the Square and Compass Club. Perhaps one of the most important positions that he has been associated with has been as potentate of Cahaba Shrine where he served as Potentate in 1999 and again in 2015.

Floyd's wife, Carmine Janice Hambrick, passed away recently leaving four children and 3 grandchildren.
