


Hello Nobles and Ladies,

NOTICE OF STATED SHRINE MEETING AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2023 AT CAHABA SHRINE

7:30 p.m. - Opening of the Temple, Regular Order of Business, Election of officers

You will elect: Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest & Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder, Imperial Reps, Southeastern Reps, Dixie Reps and 2 Finance Committee Members.

325.11 Election Regulations:

(a) **Electioneering:** A candidate of an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Expenditures Prohibited: The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) Violation: For any violation of (a) or (b) the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) Notice: At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

Use WebFez to verify your personal information, payments and Shrine activity

How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the Register button on the Login page.
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Shrine ID (found on your membership card) and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.

IPHONE: Open App Store **ANDROID**: Open Google Play Store Search: "My FezCard Viewer" and click icon Click "install" button to install app

Open My FezCard Viewer. Enter your Shrine ID and Last name. Type in Temple name and click on it to highlight it. Click "Register" button. You only need to register the first time you open app.

At the top of the screen you will have two options: Shrine Card and QR Code.

You can click "QR Code" at the top or swipe screen left to view the QR Code for scanning at Temple meetings.

<u>NOTE</u>: Your current plastic card remains valid for QR scanning at Temple meetings but headquarters no longer sends year stickers.



For information, here is Imperial ruling for civic parades from General Order #1:

2. Civic Parades. In civic parades, and non-Shrine public appearances, Nobles, their ladies, children and masonic related or sponsored organizations may participate, with the approval of the Potentate. Only Nobles may perform or compete in any vehicle, ride vehicles with fewer than four wheels, or operate any vehicle while parading, including participation with any of the clubs or units parading. In those situations, where a specific license is required by a state, due to the size, weight or passenger carrying capacity of a vehicle to be used in a parade, and should there be NO MEMBER NOBLE PROPERLY LICENSED TO OPERATE SAID VEHICLE, the temple may hire a properly licensed driver with proof of the proper license required, and verifying that the driver has an acceptable driving record according to any applicable insurance carrier(s). This driver MUST be added to the insurance policy, and accepted by the insurance company, PRIOR to his/her operating ANY vehicle on behalf of the temple.


