Dixie Shrine Association held their annual convention April 9-12 in Panama City Beach, FL. The Motor Corps did an excellent job during the competition as always. They didn't bring home the High Point Trophy, but there is always next year! There was little participation from other DSA units overall, but changes are coming next year that hopefully will encourage more participation. It was announced at the DSA annual meeting that next year's convention will be in Biloxi, MS with the mid-winter to be held in Mobile, AL. On June 7 we will be having the Cahaba Family Picnic and Social at the Temple. This will be like an old-fashioned church picnic on the lawn. It's potluck, so bring a dish to share, and if you can make ice cream, we plan to have a homemade ice cream competition. There will be activities for the kids and grandkids as well, including inflatable water slides, other inflatables for young and old, a dunking booth to dunk our Divan, and other lawn games for everyone. We hope to bring our Shrine Family together for this event.

Our Potentate's Ball will be July 26, with a meet and greet on the 25th to welcome our out-of-town guests. The Ball will be an elegant affair. I am aware my Fez is on sideways; this is my sister's fault for not telling me!





NOTICE: PROPOSAL TO AMEND CAHABA BY-LAWS

**At the Stated Shrine meeting April 25, 2025 the following proposal was made.
It will lay over until the May 16, 2025 Stated Shrine meeting for vote.**

Be it resolved, that the By-Laws Committee of Cahaba Shrine, whose names appear hereon, do recommend the following changes to be made to the by-laws of Cahaba Shrine:

ARTICLE 5 – Initiation Fees, Dues, Per Capita, Hospital Levy—Section 5.2 Dues (a) Suspension for nonpayment.

Currently: A member who is two years in arrears on his dues is suspended, pursuant to the procedure recited in the bylaws of Shriners International, unless this temple votes to remit his dues.

Proposed: A member who is ~~two years~~ **one year** in arrears on his dues is suspended, pursuant to the procedure recited in the bylaws of Shriners International, unless this temple votes to remit his dues.

ARTICLE 7 – Committees—Section 7.1 Leadership Search Committee

Currently: This temple shall have a Leadership Search Committee. Its appointment and duties are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

Proposed: (to be consistent with Article 4 Officers 4.8(a) Leadership Search Committee): This temple ~~shall have~~ **may appoint** a Leadership Search Committee. Its appointment and duties are governed by the bylaws of Shriners International.

ARTICLE 9 – Temple Units & Shrine Clubs—Section 9.3 Membership (a) Units

Currently: Temple units must be composed solely of members of this temple. The fez of the temple must be worn at all appropriate times except for such units which do not normally wear fezzes.

Proposed: ~~Temple units must be composed solely of members of this temple~~ **may include Nobles of other temples. All members of the units who are regular or associate members of Cahaba Shriners are eligible to hold office.** The Fez of the Temple must be worn at all appropriate times except for such units which do not normally wear fezzes.

BE IT RESOLVED, that these proposed amendments be held over until a stated meeting to be announced, at which time they will be presented for vote by the nobility.

NOTICE: PROPOSAL TO MEMBERSHIP FOR DUES INCREASE

**At the Stated Shrine meeting April 25, 2025 the following proposal was made.
It will lay over until the May 16, 2025 Stated Shrine meeting for vote.**

It is a difficult decision for any Temple to make to discuss a dues increase. Rates too low result in not enough funds to operate and still provide services to members. Rates too high effect member retainment and recruitment. We don't want to lose an opportunity to be more profitable either.

We must consider at this time adjusting dues to increase income because of:

Membership Losses – our current membership stands at 761 (plus 11 associates), our lowest ever. Internationally, the combined population of the Shrine fraternity is at 180,000 nationwide and this trend is continuing.

Inflation has been consistently increasing every year and still is. While dues income decreases, our expenses continue to rise, from operational costs to fundraising expenses, causing potential budget shortfalls each year. Attendance has declined at Shrine meetings and all Shrine functions and costs continue to outpace revenues.

Profitable investment opportunities have been fully utilized to safeguard the funds we have now; however, our annual operating budget falls far below expectations where income is concerned.

Cahaba Shrine has not increased dues in 30 years. Thirty years ago, membership was 1,828

Twenty years ago, membership was 1,520

Ten years ago, membership was 1,277

Five years ago, membership was 832

Since the last dues increase we have had a **58.4% DECREASE** in membership, and average age of the membership is 67.

Of the \$100.00 dues paid by each regular member, the Temple only receives \$45.00. It is proposed that Temple dues be raised an additional \$30.00, bringing annual dues to \$130.00.
