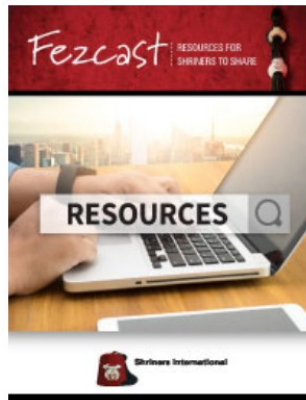

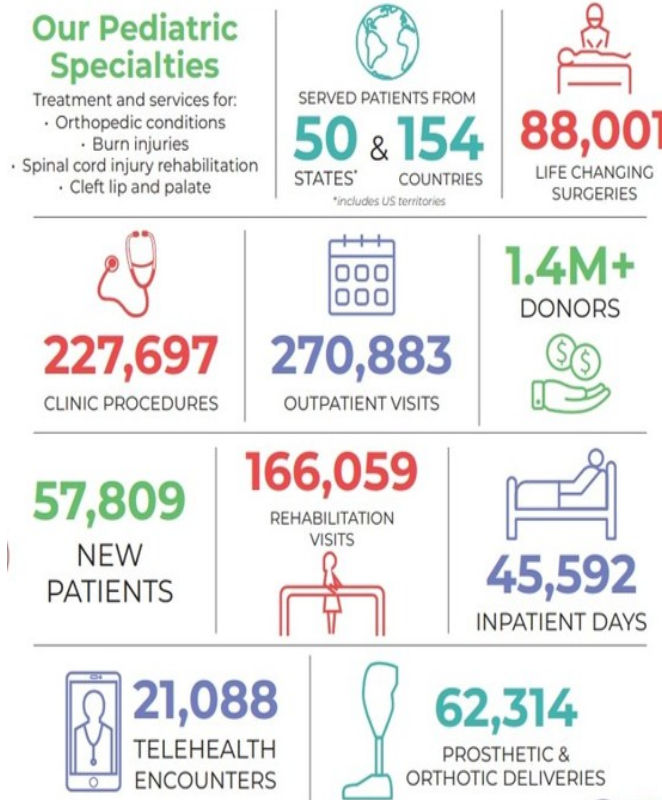

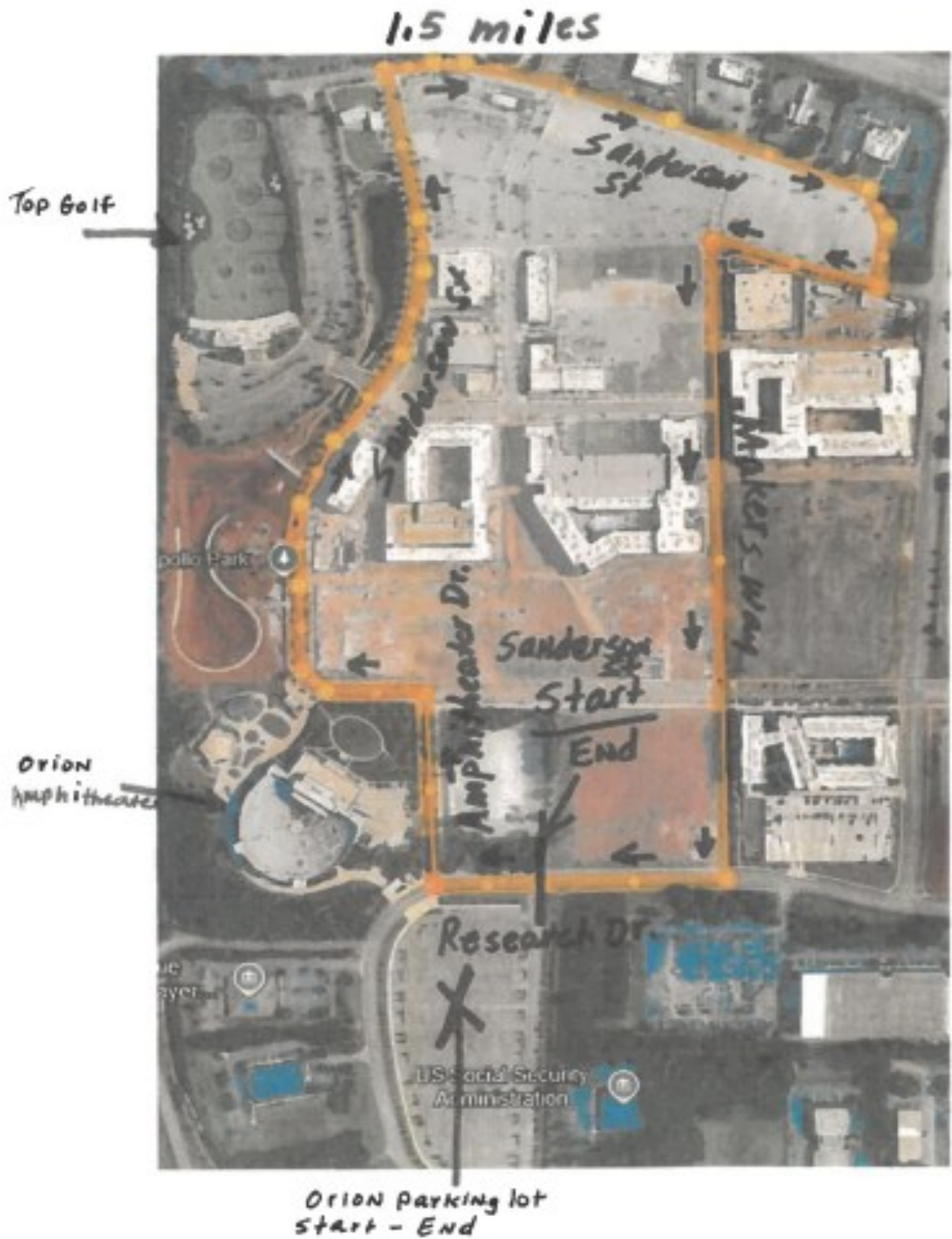

SESA PARADE ROUTE—MIDCITY



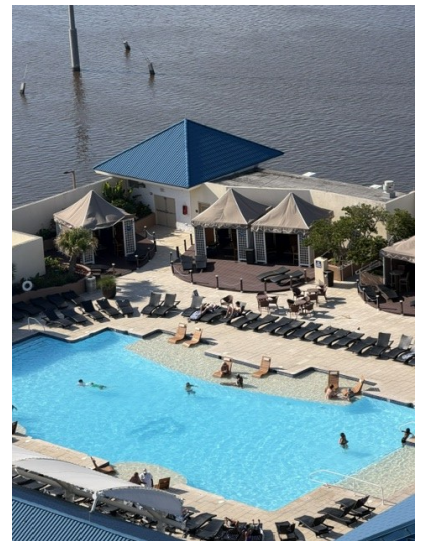

How to Register for WebFez:

- Go to your browser's address bar and type in webfez.shrinenet.org
- Click the **Register** button on the Login page.
- From the Registration page, choose your Temple from the drop-down list and then type in your Shrine ID (found on your membership card) and your First and Last names.
- Click on the Register button. You will be directed to the Create a New Account page. On this page enter an E-mail address that you will use to log in with, confirm the E-mail address, and then enter and confirm your Password.

You can click "QR Code" at the top or swipe screen left to view the QR Code for scanning at Temple meetings.

If you see a white (blank) screen when accessing your card, rotate the phone left and right until digital image appears.

NOTE: Your plastic card remains valid for QR scanning at Shrine meetings but headquarters no longer sends year stickers.
